

Application deadline: Rolling deadline till the position is filled. First come, first considered. Tentative Start Date: As soon as possible Tentative End Date: 2025-12-31 (with possibility of extension depending on performance)

Pickup Truck Driver & Green Ambassador

Type of position: Casual timesheet (Indpendent contractors), mostly in-person work, possibility for renewal

Hourly rate: \$21/h

Duration: Until the end of 2025, with a possibility to renew depending on performance. Structure: Fluctuating times based on events schedules that involve atypical work hours. *enuf* encourages a four-day work week. In our context, means that no one will be asked to work or be given shifts that exceed 32h within a 7 day period. In some cases, the 32 hours may be spread over more than 4 days within a week in our atypical hours context.

Description and Responsibilities:

The responsibilities in this position are twofold: 1) Pickup truck driver (primary, required), and 2) a green ambassador (GA) (optional for additional hours).

1) Pickup truck driver (Primary role) is the main person tasked with driving the company vehicles (a pickup truck and a passenger car) for various purposes, including the following:

- Organic waste collection: this will involve tasks such as the following:
 - collecting organic waste from clients.
 - communicating with clients before and during the pick up.
 - dropping organic waste off at partner composting facilities.
 - Data tracking activities such as weighing the collected waste, and tracking mileage and gas purchases.
- Surplus food:
 - Coordinate the delivery of untouched surplus food to our community fridges. This may involve driving our company car, or personal car (gas will be reimbursed in this case).
 - Maintain proper records.
- Waste audits: this will involve additional tasks such as participating in the audits. At waste audits, we empty waste bins, and sort and weigh their content.



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- Workshops at elementary and secondary schools: This may involve additional tasks such as assisting the *enuf* team members in conducting those workshops.
- Ensure that the *enuf* vehicles remain clean and in working order (including but not limited to refilling the gas as necessary).
- Coordinate maintenance and repair for the *enuf* vehicles.
- Maintain a well-supplied inventory for various activities, including supplies for audits, workshops, events and green brigade activities. Flag when resupplies are needed.

2) An *enuf* GA (Optional for additional hours) is the primary person to be called on to conduct the activities of enuf as follows:

- Participate in events by client organizations. The GA will be assigned in teams to events in the area of greater Montreal where food and/or drink is served to help inform the community how to sort their waste properly at waste stations. The GA will:
 - Stand next to waste stations and help participants learn how to sort their waste.
 - Help event organizers by being adaptive and exercising good problem-solving skills to deal with surprises.
 - Possibly deliver untouched surplus food to our community fridges. This may involve driving our company car, or personal car (gas will be reimbursed in this case).
- Participate in events organized by enuf:
 - This includes setting up tables, serving food, cleaning up, and educating the Concordia community on waste sorting during events such as Bring Your Own Mug events.
- Support the team in delivering class presentations at Universities.

Important flags:

- Green brigade work involves standing throughout long shifts that can take place during atypical hours (evenings, weekends, early mornings, etc).
- Some of the events we go to (e.g. festivals) are outside and involve unpredictable weather.
- Timesheets are required to provide at least 2 half days a week where they can be directly assigned brigade shifts (one week notice). Interns are required to provide 3 half days.



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Essential Requirements:

- Valid driver's license.
- Must be able to comfortably lift 50 pounds
- Fluency in English and French.
- Customer service experience.
- Physically comfortable with standing for long periods of time.
- Comfort with being publicly visible (e.g. in our social media and picture campaigns).

Assets:

- Multilingual (beyond the required English and French).
- Knowledge of waste management and the composting processes.
